Our horses need to be viewed during the operations that our tax dollars pay for from the actual gather operations on a daily basis through the closed doors of long term holding. The welfare of our wild herds mandated by Congress to "humane" treatment cannot be left to the supposed experts that have been guilty of deliberate activities to hide their actions." states Plaintiff Laura Leigh.
